Modi govt faces flak on dam

The soon to be resumed NHPC ([/taxonomy/term/651](#)) work is expected to put the Assam ([/taxonomy/term/548](#)) BJP leadership in trouble in the face of the stiff resistance from many parties and organizations.

KMSS ([/taxonomy/term/428](#)), who has been spearheading the protest ([/taxonomy/term/412](#)) threatens to go for a mass agitation if the authorities fail to halt.
