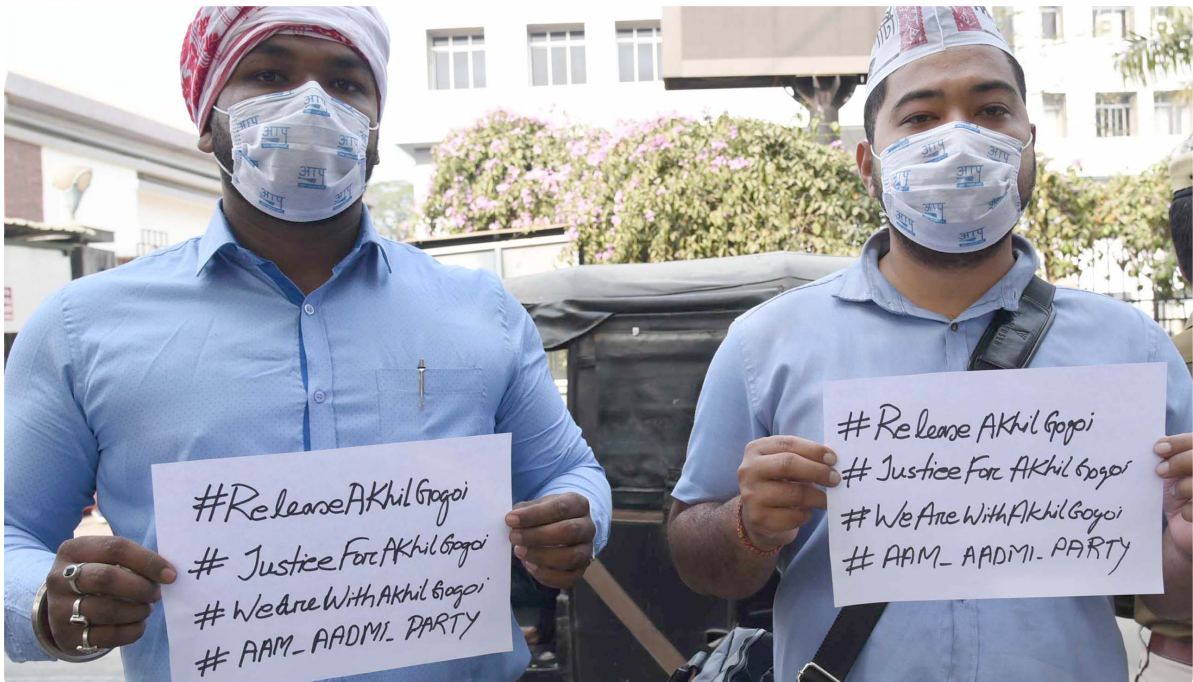


No bail, Akhil to move SC

Guwahati: The Gauhati High Court has rejected the bail petition of Akhil Gogoi much to the major disappointment of the Rajor Dal which is holding its state convention in Moran on Thursday.

A division bench of the court comprising Justice Kalyan Rai Churana and Justice Ajit Barthakur rejected the petition in the morning.

Gogoi, the peasant leader (KMSS), the parent body of the Rajor Dal won't be able to come out of the bail where he was remanded last year during the anti CAA stir.
