### No let-up in flood fury

There seems to be no let-up in the overall flood scene in Assam on Wednesday with incessant rains in many parts of the state ([/taxonomy/term/2332](#)) along with the catchment areas in Arunachal ([/taxonomy/term/2194](#)) Pradesh. The mighty Brahmaputra ([/taxonomy/term/2226](#)) and its tributaries have been flowing abode the danger ([/taxonomy/term/1965](#)) level ([/taxonomy/term/2232](#)) suggesting a grim scene during the next couple of days.

The current flood waters (/taxonomy/term/2337) have inundated the Kaziranga (/taxonomy/term/122) National (/taxonomy/term/1874) Park forcing many birds and animals to move to the nearby Karbi hills area.

The Pobitora sanctuary is still reeling water flood waters (/taxonomy/term/2337). On the other hand, flood waters (/taxonomy/term/2337) have entered more and more areas in Sonitpur, Morigaon (/taxonomy/term/101), Lakhimpur and Dhemaji forcing the authority to expedite relief and rescue operations.
