No maggi please

After weeks of will-it-won't-it, the Assam government restricts sale of maggi ([/taxonomy/term/2178](#)) from Thursday. The decision was finalized hours after the experts found ([/taxonomy/term/1802](#)) the substance of lead ([/taxonomy/term/1657](#)) and MSG in the Nestle product.

Health ([/taxonomy/term/51](#)) minister Dr Nazrul Islam who received the report from the laboratory has finally asked the authority to restrict sale and purchase of maggi ([/taxonomy/term/2178](#)). On Wednesday the health ([/taxonomy/term/51](#)) department collected the maggi ([/taxonomy/term/2178](#)) samples and conducted test at the laboratory where the inadmissible substances surfaced.

Chief minister Tarun Gogoi (/taxonomy/term/2150) asked the health department to submit a report by Thursday to clear its stand on the maggi (/taxonomy/term/2178) controversy (/taxonomy/term/1752).
