### No movement on NH No 37!

The current flood wave in Kaziranga ([/taxonomy/term/122](#)) is likely to force the authority to suspend the movement of traffic on the National ([/taxonomy/term/1874](#)) Highway No 37.

According to information, a huge portion of the vital road in the state ([/taxonomy/term/2332](#)) has come under the surging waters ([/taxonomy/term/2337](#)) of the Brahmaputra ([/taxonomy/term/2226](#)) causing immense misery for the birds and wild animals.

Herds of wild elephants are waiting to shift to the nearby karbi hills. A number of rhinos in the national park have already crossed the road while some others have not been able to do it because of the flood waters (/taxonomy/term/2337). Many deer and buffalos have been reeling under the flood waters (/taxonomy/term/2337).

The forest guards (/taxonomy/term/2185) have rescued (/taxonomy/term/1630) a rhino calf from the flood waters (/taxonomy/term/2337). The hapless animal (/taxonomy/term/2081) has been sent to the rehabilitation camp for treatment.
