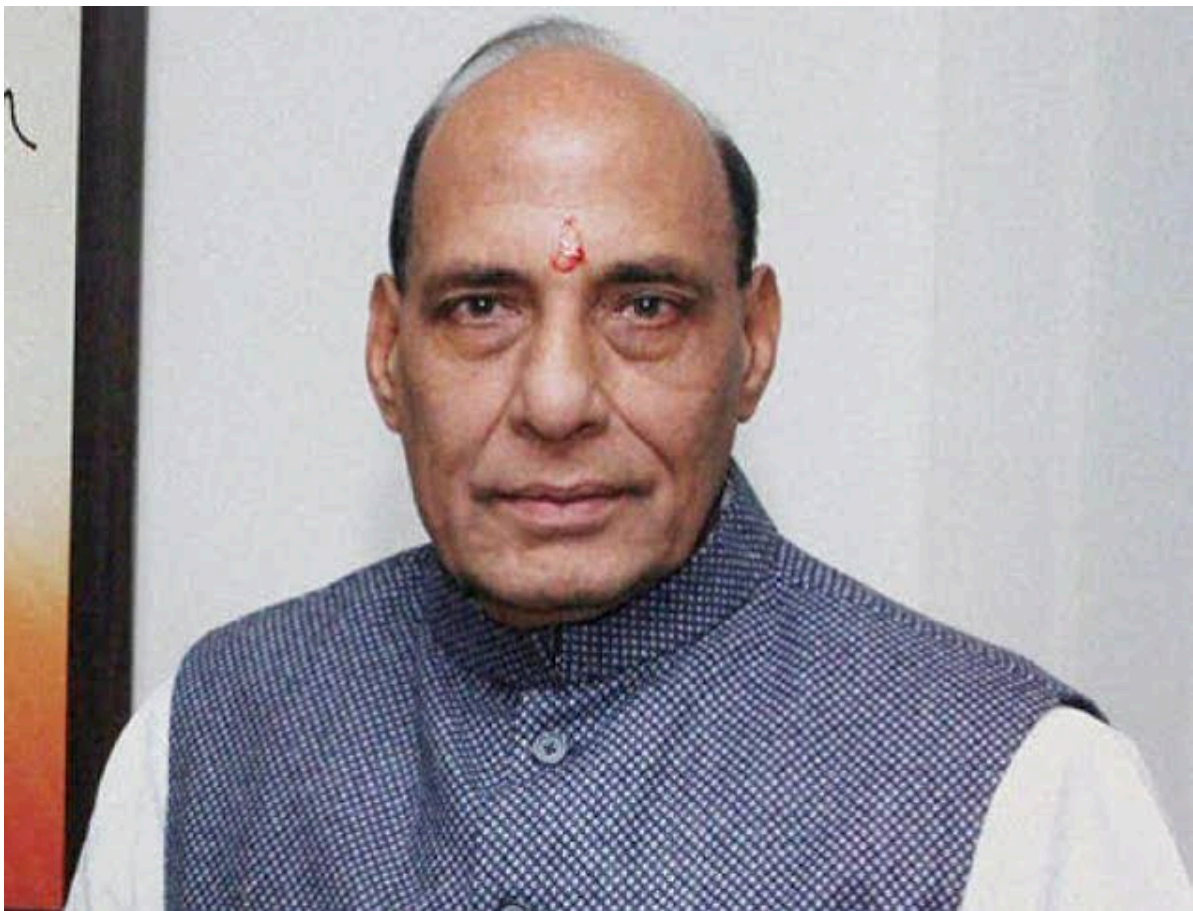

No reason to be worried over NRC

NEW DELHI: Union home minister Rajnath Singh said no Indian living in Assam would be left out in the updated NRC in Assam.

Replying to Saugata Roy (/taxonomy/term/1639) of
Trinamool Congress (/taxonomy/term/90) in
Parliament (/taxonomy/term/1963) on Thursday,
Singh said process is on to update NRC
in the north eastern state (/taxonomy/term/2332)
under the direct supervision of the
Supreme Court.

Singh was responding to Roy (/taxonomy/term/1639) who alleged that NRC is a conspiracy in Assam against the Bangla speaking people in the state (/taxonomy/term/2332). His party chief and West Bengal chief minister Mamata Banerjee on Wednesday asked her MPs (/taxonomy/term/1935) to go all out against NRC in Parliament (/taxonomy/term/1963). She in her address in a public rally in Birbhum called it a conspiracy to drive out the Bangla speaking lots and said that if these people are tortured she won't remain calm.
