### No respite from armyworms

Despite stepped up measures, the armyworms menace (/taxonomy/term/2371) in the crops fields in Assam refuses to die down. The menace (/taxonomy/term/2371) keeps spreading to more and more areas much to the major disappointment of the farming community (/taxonomy/term/2084) who fear (/taxonomy/term/2009) a feminine-like situation in the state (/taxonomy/term/2332).

Now altogether 22 districts have been grappling with the menace (/taxonomy/term/2371) forcing the government to step up measures to deal (/taxonomy/term/1922) with the situation where crops on more than 31, 000 hectares land have been damaged.

The worst-hit district is Golaghat which is followed by Majuli apart from Dibrugarh, Jorhat, Sivasagar. The newly affected districts include Charaideo, Darrang, Nagaon, Morigaon (/taxonomy/term/101), Kamrup, Sonitpur, Dhemaji and Biswanath.
