The brief respite from the rain water woes in Guwahati ended when rains resumed in the city (/taxonomy/term/1957) on Friday.

Many areas in Nabin Nagar, Anil Nagar, Lachit Nagar, Zoo Road have again come under the rainwaters in the afternoon against (/taxonomy/term/1929) disrupting the normal (/taxonomy/term/2062) life in the premier north eastern city (/taxonomy/term/1957).

The fresh rains that lashed the city (/taxonomy/term/1957) on Friday afternoon resulted in a heavy traffic snarls on the GS Road and RG Baruah Road much to the major inconvenience for the commuters who heaved a sigh of relief in the morning.
