Normalcy back in Salmara

Normalcy is back [\(/taxonomy/term/1264\)](#) to Baksa [\(/taxonomy/term/1088\)](#) and Barpeta [\(/taxonomy/term/643\)](#) district four days after suspected NDFB-S [\(/taxonomy/term/631\)](#) militants district killed [\(/taxonomy/term/839\)](#) four local lemon traders forcing the authorities to clamp curfew [\(/taxonomy/term/954\)](#) fearing the recurrence of BTAD clash [\(/taxonomy/term/870\)](#).

But security forces [\(/taxonomy/term/1285\)](#) are still on round-the-clock vigil to thwart any attempt to monger ethnic frenzy in the BTAD [\(/taxonomy/term/746\)](#) areas in the wake of the attack on the minority [\(/taxonomy/term/1265\)](#) traders.

The angry non-Bodo (/taxonomy/term/656) people in Barpeta (/taxonomy/term/643) district have threatened to launch a massive protest (/taxonomy/term/412) against the incident where four lemon traders were killed (/taxonomy/term/839) after being kidnapped (/taxonomy/term/1385) on the way from a market at Labdangpar along the Barpeta (/taxonomy/term/643)-Baksa (/taxonomy/term/1088) inter district border (/taxonomy/term/665).

The bodies were recovered from the Beki (/taxonomy/term/1194) river on Sunday (/taxonomy/term/1006) sending shock and angers across the BTAD (/taxonomy/term/746) areas.
