

Panel to study waterlogging



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Chief Minister Tarun [Gogoi](#) on [Saturday](#) asked the authorities to set up a committee to study the [flood](#) problem of [Guwahati](#) and suggest remedial measures to solve the problem.

[Gogoi](#) asked additional Chief Secretary of [Guwahati](#) Development Department V Pyarelal to constitute the committee and the [Guwahati](#) Metropolitan Development Authority will provide necessary logistical support to the committee.
