Peace to come from political fight

Manipur (/taxonomy/term/64) rights (/taxonomy/term/1990) activist Irom Sharmila said that peace would come to the restive north eastern state (/taxonomy/term/2332) through political effort.

In her address at a function in Delhi University, she said that if voted to power she would spare no pain to restore peace to the north eastern region where the draconian Act (/taxonomy/term/1974) like the Arms Forces Special Powers Act (/taxonomy/term/1974) would have no place.
