PM to open investors' summit: Sonowal

NEW DELHI: Chief Minister Sarbananda Sonowal said Assam will be a major south east (/taxonomy/term/2485) Asian destination for foreign investment when the north eastern state (/taxonomy/term/2332) is hosting the global investors' summit (/taxonomy/term/1971) in the capital city of Guwahati in February. Addressing a press conference in New Delhi (/taxonomy/term/1868) on Friday Sonowal said Prime Minister Narendra Modi (/taxonomy/term/2361) is opening the three days summit (/taxonomy/term/1971) which will beckon the foreign investors.

“We want a pollution free environment. We want industrial growth without hampering the ecology. Now Assam is a nice place for the investors. This will help the state (/taxonomy/term/2332) engage lakhs of unemployed youths directly and indirectly in it,” said Sonowal. Before that Sonowal along with his industry minister Chandra Mohan Patowary held a brainstorming session with half a dozen of foreign ambassadors who are participating in the upcoming event.
