### Post flood blues for cattle farming

Flood waters ([/taxonomy/term/2337](#)) receded in Majuli. But the biggest river island on the planet has yet to get out of the blues. The post flood scene takes a pathetic turn in Tikira Chapori area where dairy farming has suffered a serious setback. More than 400 cows died soon ([/taxonomy/term/2206](#)) after the outbreak of a disease which has taken an epidemic turn.

With 8000 cows in 77 sheds, hundreds of farmers have been earning bread and butter for years. In yet another incident, a huge herd of wild elephant has trampled many cowsheds on Saturday night.

An Asom Jatiyatabadi Yuba Chatra Parishad (AJYCP (/taxonomy/term/1764)) delegation rushed to the spot on Sunday and took stock of the situation. Local cattle famers apprised the AJYCP (/taxonomy/term/1764) team of the pathetic scene which is a major setback for the entire diary sub sector.
