PPFA thanks US Prez

Patriotic Peoples' Front Assam (PPFA) appreciates newly crowned US [President](#) [Donald Trump](#) for his gesture to [India](#) [terming the largest democracy of the globe as](#) [‘a true friend and partner in addressing challenges around the world’](#). The northeast [India](#) based patriotic forum also expressed happiness that [President](#) [Trump](#) called Indian Prime Minister [Narendra Modi](#) on 24 January 2017 to invite the latter for visiting the United States later this year.

Both the powerful politicians discussed opportunities to strengthen the partnership between the US (/taxonomy/term/1702) and India (/taxonomy/term/2367) in broad areas such as (/taxonomy/term/2291) the economy and defense. They also talked about the security scenario in the region of South & Central Asia and finally resolved that both the democratic nations stand shoulder to shoulder in the global fight (/taxonomy/term/2073) against (/taxonomy/term/1929) terrorism (/taxonomy/term/1812).

“We find no reason to condemn President (/taxonomy/term/2432) Trump for his American first policy (/taxonomy/term/2366) and believe that every nationalistic leader (/taxonomy/term/1820) has the right to pursue his patriotism without harming other nation’s interest,” said a statement issued by the PPEFA.

The forum also denounced the apprehension of some non-resident Indians taking shelter in the US (/taxonomy/term/1702) because of President (/taxonomy/term/2432) Trump’s aggressive nationalistic policy (/taxonomy/term/2366) and argued that the proposed anti-terror strategy of the Republican leader (/taxonomy/term/1820) would finally benefit India (/taxonomy/term/2367) as (/taxonomy/term/2291) a whole in the long run.

“We visualize India (/taxonomy/term/2367)’s enhancing role in the international arena after President (/taxonomy/term/2432) Trump joins hands with Russian President (/taxonomy/term/2432) Vladimir Putin to counter international terrorism (/taxonomy/term/1812) affectively. We are optimistic that New Delhi (/taxonomy/term/1868) would nurture the relationship for a greater cause without compromising our national interest,” concluded the statement.
