Protested Swami in Kokrajhar

Protest wave continued in Assam against [\(/taxonomy/term/1929\)](#) BJP leader [\(/taxonomy/term/1820\)](#) and Member of Parliament [\(/taxonomy/term/1963\)](#) Dr Subramaniam Swami's remarks on mixed of religion and politics while visiting to the state that Kokrajhar district committee of All Assam Minority Students Union(AAMSU [\(/taxonomy/term/1900\)](#)) and All BTC Minority Students Union(ABMSU) protested and burnt effigy of Dr Swami.

Hundreds of AAMSU (/taxonomy/term/1900) and ABMSU activists and publics with banner, placards took out a rally and hit the street shouting slogans on Sunday at Fakiragram along the Bilasipara-Serfanguri and Bhotgaon along JD Road in protest against (/taxonomy/term/1929) remarks of Swami and later burnt effigy of Swami and demanded banning of BJP leader (/taxonomy/term/1820) Swami's step to Assam who allegedly has been trying to create communal clash in the state in the name of politics.

Rafikul Islam, AAMSU (/taxonomy/term/1900) leader (/taxonomy/term/1820) strongly reacted Swami's remarks on religion as India represents secular in its status. He said that BJP leader (/taxonomy/term/1820) Swami was trying to create to communal resented in the state, for which why he is making irrelevant remarks. He said that they (AAMSU (/taxonomy/term/1900)) would not allow Swami to make any communal comments. The AAMSU (/taxonomy/term/1900) further asked the government not to allow the BJP leader (/taxonomy/term/1820) to visit the state and his stepping to Assam should be banned.
