

R Day celebrated in Udalguri district with gaiety

The 68th Republic Day has been [celebrated](#) in [Udalguri](#) district with gaiety. At district HQ [Udalguri](#), BTC Deputy Chief Khampa Borgayari hoisted the tricolour in presence of more than [ten](#) thousand people including woman and children. Speaking on the occasion BTC Dy Chief gratefully remembered the contribution of Kanak Lata Barua and others who had sacrificed their lives for the freedom of our country. On the occasion BTC Deputy Chief Khampa Borgayari and DC Sadhana Hojai felicitated wildlife activists Jayanta [Das](#) and Ismail Daimari for their contribution in the field of conservation of nature and wildlife.
