### Rain forecast triggers fear of grim flood

Heavy rains and thundersquall is likely to hit hard the north eastern states on Tuesday triggering the fear ([/taxonomy/term/2009](#)) of a deteriorating flood situation in Assam.

According to the weather reports, the sky would be cloudy in the next 24 hours even after the premier city ([/taxonomy/term/1957](#)) of Guwahati recorded a huge temperature.

Rains are expected mainly in Assam and Meghalaya (</taxonomy/term/2343>) which is likely to take place in some isolated places in the neighbouring states of Manipur (</taxonomy/term/64>), Nagaland (</taxonomy/term/1597>), Tripura (</taxonomy/term/1738>) and Mizoram.

Weather men at the RMC on Tuesday talks of 33.3 degree Celsius in Guwahati which is less than the northern districts which stands at a maximum temperature of 34.5 degree Celsius.
