Rebel diktat muffles R Day celebrations

Joint Statement against the Celebration of India's Republic Day in Our WESEA Region

India is using various nefarious plots to perpetuate its forcible occupation of Western South East Asia (WESEA). One of them is the dirty old trick of pitting one ethnic group against another. By sowing seeds of communal hatred among the people of the region, especially in Assam, Manipur and Meghalaya, they are trying to clutter the age-old harmonious fabric of society.

With just two days to go for the Republic Day celebrations, fraternal outfits (CorCom, GNLA (/taxonomy/term/130), HNLC, ULFA (/taxonomy/term/124) (I)) Monday issued a joint statement asserting that India (/taxonomy/term/2367) is using various nefarious plots to perpetuate forcible occupation of Western South East Asia (WESEA), one of which is the dirty old trick of pitting one ethnic group (/taxonomy/term/2415) against (/taxonomy/term/1929) another.

“By sowing seeds of communal hatred among the people of the region, especially in Assam, Manipur (/taxonomy/term/64) and Meghalaya (/taxonomy/term/2343), they are trying to shatter the age-old harmonious fabric of society,” stated the communiqué.

The outfits are of the opinion that underhanded dealings of Delhi with some armed and unarmed groups to sabotage the liberation struggle are increasing day by day. By encouraging the parochial sectarian agenda of some communities, the Government of Indian is trying to upset the peaceful co-existence of numerous ethnic groups of the region. The venom of communal hatred is so widespread in Manipur (/taxonomy/term/64) that there is the danger (/taxonomy/term/1965) of igniting communal clashes any day if we are caught (/taxonomy/term/2308) in the trap of the enemy.

Another oft-repeated dirty trick they feel is the use of surrendered militants in many shady activities in order to derail the liberation movement. India (/taxonomy/term/2367) is yet to learn the lesson that it is a useless venture, which would only result in the end of the miserable lives of those cowards who betrayed their people.

Besides, the Indian leadership’s sheer lack of humanity and arrogance is amply exemplified by the recent controversial and infamous demonetization of some denominations of Indian currency.

“One (/taxonomy/term/2177) cannot but appalled by the obsession of personal aggrandizement and egotism displayed by Indian leaders (/taxonomy/term/2082). Lack of understanding and sympathy for the underprivileged masses of mainland India (/taxonomy/term/2367) who suffered immensely due to this fiasco is so great that we are even more convinced of the level (/taxonomy/term/2232) of stupidity and cruelty of Indian governance.

The release questioned as (/taxonomy/term/2291) to how would the people of WESEA, which was never a part of India (/taxonomy/term/2367), expect anything good from this country, which has no qualms about unleashing brutality on its own citizens?

“It will be a grave mistake on the part of the Indian military commanders if they consider our concern for human casualty in the ensuing freedom struggle as (/taxonomy/term/2291) a sign (/taxonomy/term/1687) of weakness. Regaining our lost sovereignty by defeating the evil designs of India (/taxonomy/term/2367) is the only way to a dignified existence of the people of WESEA. As (/taxonomy/term/2291) India (/taxonomy/term/2367)’s celebration of Republic Day in WESEA is a stark reminder of colonization of the region by India (/taxonomy/term/2367), we ought to dissociate ourselves from it,” the release sharply remarked.

The outfits collectively called out to the people of the region to boycott the 68th Republic Day of India (/taxonomy/term/2367). They appealed to the people of the WESEA to do so by safely staying at home supporting a total shut down of activities from 21:00 hours of January 25 to 18:00 of January 26, 2017.

The restriction however, is not applicable to emergency services which should function normally during the mentioned hours.
