Rehabilitation grant

The Kokrajhar district administration ceremonially distributed the Rehabilitation Grant and Financial Assistance to the family victim of the carnage ([/taxonomy/term/2011](#)) on December 23 last in Kokrajhar district, which was announced by the Union Government at a meeting held at DC office conference hall today in Kokrajhar.

Each of the deceased family members of 33, who were killed was given away Rs.3 lakh as ex-gratia from union government in the presence of public leaders ([/taxonomy/term/2082](#)).

Deputy Commissioner, Kokrajhar Thaneswar Malakar said the final ex-gratia which was announced by the union government were distributed among victim families and 1,792 families each of be provided Rs 50,000 for rehabilitation grant (/taxonomy/term/2065), whose houses were totally burned and injured persons would be given grants-in-aid as per announcement.
