

Resentment over free textbook

The sudden decision of Assam government to distribute free text books among government aided school students across the [state](#) draws resentment from various sections including the All Assam Publishers and [Book](#) Sellers Association. Terming the move [as](#) disastrous for the book [publishers](#) of the [state](#), GiriPad Devchodhury, proprietor of Bani Prakash urged the government to change its order. Otherwise, it would bring about havoc to the publishing industry of the [state](#), Devchodhury added.

Noted critic Dr. Hiren Gohain also has expressed concern [over](#) the government move.

All Assam Students' Association (AASU), on the other hand, protested [against](#) the free distribution of text books [as](#) the students are not availing books. All the students' organizations urged the government to take urgent step for proper distribution of the text books.

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
