### Resentment over tickets for Panery LAC

With just a couple of days left for the upcoming assembly elections in Assam, the ticket aspirants of Congress ([/taxonomy/term/90](#)), BJP have started campaigning by pasting banners, hoardings and by organizing meetings in Tangla ([/taxonomy/term/56](#)) and its neighboring areas under 64 No. Panery constituency for showing their strength as ([/taxonomy/term/2291](#)) candidates.
