"At present there comes great threat for the Khilanjiya jati-Janagosthi'. The formation of population had completely changed. The AIUDF chief of Assam had raised question in the Loksabha for 10% reservation for the Muslims. Besides the president also said to the news persons to complete the construction of Barpeta Medical college as early as possible. The BJP president also informed the news persons that their party would soon started a programme" Gaoloi Bolok" and before that programme they had visited various places of the district like Chenga, Sarthebari and Barpeta town and held Karmi Sabha. He added that the migration problem also becomes a threat for Assam.
