

SDPO body guard injured in ULFA attack



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A senior police officer had a narrow escape at a shoot out in Sivasagar on Friday. But his body guard sustained bullet injured in the incident.

The incident took place near Barhat where three motorcycle born ULFA men started indiscriminate firing on a sub divisional police officer at around 7 in the evening. The senior police officer escaped unhurt but his personal security guard Kamal Nath sustained bullet injury. He was rushed to the hospital. The incident took a couple of days after ULFA's Paresh Baruah faction threatened to launch massive attack.
