Siang water not fit for consumption

PASIGHAT: The Siang ([/taxonomy/term/2180](#)) water is not at all fit for human consumption. Turbidity NTU is 482 while Iron as Fe, mg/l is 1.65 which are found ([/taxonomy/term/1802](#)) to be beyond permissible limit. This was what the findings of the water testing report of the State Water Quality Testing Laboratory (SWQTL), under the Chief Engineer (Sanitation) PHE & WS department in Itanagar ([/taxonomy/term/2394](#)) submitted the water testing report of Siang ([/taxonomy/term/2180](#)) River based on the water sample collected and sent on last week. Experts say at normal ([/taxonomy/term/2062](#)) levels, iron is not deadly to any aquatic animals but unusually high amounts of iron exist in water may lead ([/taxonomy/term/1657](#)) to adverse changes in colour, odour and taste of water and has negative effects on aquatic populations, behavior and health.
