Sonowal's effigy burnt

The All Assam Minority Students Union (AAMSU ([/taxonomy/term/1900](#))) protested the eviction drive along Kaziranga ([/taxonomy/term/122](#)) Bandordubi and burnt effigies ([/taxonomy/term/2016](#)) of Chief Minister Sarbananda Sonowal, Ministers Himanta Biswa Sarma and Keshab Mahanta at Fakiragram in Kokrajhar district today.

Hundreds of AAMSU (/taxonomy/term/1900) activists and citizens took part with placards and shouted slogans against (/taxonomy/term/1929) BJP led alliance government at Dispur in the protest step with burning of effigies (/taxonomy/term/2016) of CM and ministers (/taxonomy/term/2422).

Students union strongly slammed the eviction drive along Kaziranga (/taxonomy/term/122), who are living since long years and demanded eviction should be stopped.

Anowar Hussain, AAMSU (/taxonomy/term/1900) leader (/taxonomy/term/1820) condemned eviction drive which has created resented among residents.
