## State govt responsible for teachers' salary: Hagrama

BTC Supremo Hagrama Mahillary and Rajya Sabha MP Biswajit Daimary attended a mass rally for BPF candidate of 65 No. Kalaigaon LAC Maheswar Boro at Khoirabari on Thursday.
