

Statue of Lord Buddha from Thailand unveiled in Guwahati



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A statue from Thailand dedicated to Lord Buddha unveiled Buddha [temple](#) in Mitta Bhava Buddha Monastery [Campus](#) at Lokhora, Guwahati on Wednesday. On occasion of Buddha Purnima, one of the most revered festival of Buddhism the statue was unveiled at presence of devotees. After hoisting the Buddhist International flag in the Buddha [temple](#) inside the [campus](#) the idol was unveiled by Buddhist priest Bhangte Nyane Tishai.
