It is really a matter of shame that the culprits who are involved in the rape against two indigenous ladies in the Udalguri district are yet to be arrested. Civil Society organisations in different parts of Assam have demanded for the arrests of the culprits and provide justice to the victims. The central committee of All Bodo Students Union (ABSU) tagged a three hour Dharna in the Dispur Last Gate on 5th December demanding justice to the rape victims.
