Sukumar Basumatary remembered

The Bodo Sahitya Sabha (/taxonomy/term/46) recalled contributions of late Sukumar Basumatary, who is regarded as (/taxonomy/term/2291) Bodo folklorist (Bodo Khuga Thunlaini Oja) towards growth of Bodo literary, on his 20th death anniversary (/taxonomy/term/2091) on Tuesday.
