Three elephants electrocuted to death in two places

GUWAHATI:In yet another bizarre incident that sends huge shockwaves across the animal lovers, three wild elephants were electrocuted to death in two different incidents in the state (/taxonomy/term/2332) on Monday.

The first tragic (/taxonomy/term/2201) incident took place in Amguri where two full grown female elephants were electrocuted as a herd of elephants which came down from the nearby hills in search of food landed at Tiphuk Tea garden in the wee hours.

Local tea garden workers (/taxonomy/term/2406) spotted the body in the morning. "Very tragic (/taxonomy/term/2201), pathetic indeed. Both the female elephants perhaps were moving under the high voltage wires," said Vinit Munda (/taxonomy/term/1730), a local tea garden worker.

The second one incident of elephant electrocution took place in Numligarh, the place where over (/taxonomy/term/2166) a dozen of wild elephants were electrocuted to death during the last two years.
