ULFA-I claims I-Day bombing responsibility

The United Liberation Front of Asom (ULFA [\(/taxonomy/term/124\)](#)-I) on Tuesday owned up the responsibility of the serial explosions when the state [\(/taxonomy/term/2332\)](#) joined the country wide Independence Day on Monday.

In a statement, ULFA [\(/taxonomy/term/124\)](#)-I publicity secretary Aronodoy Asom said that they ensured that not even a single indigenous [\(/taxonomy/term/2124\)](#) person was killed or injured in the explosions. He said that the armed protest was never aimed at terrorizing the indigenous [\(/taxonomy/term/2124\)](#) lot. According to him, the celebration was imposed in Assam.
