### Uproar in the Assam assembly

Assam legislative assembly got underway in Dispur amid a story note on Monday. Opposition Congress (/taxonomy/term/90) and AIUDF did not allow governor Banwarilal Purohit to complete his speech to mark the start (/taxonomy/term/1707) of the session which will end in March.

Uproar started as (/taxonomy/term/2291) soon (/taxonomy/term/2206) as (/taxonomy/term/2291) the governor appreciated the Sarbananda Sonowal government for good governance and fight (/taxonomy/term/2073) against (/taxonomy/term/1929) corruption.

Congress (/taxonomy/term/90) and AIUDF members stood up and raised strong protest against (/taxonomy/term/1929) the speech. They shouted that the state (/taxonomy/term/2332) has never seen any sign (/taxonomy/term/1687) of good and transparent governance. Price rise, law and order are still remaining a grave issue, said Congress (/taxonomy/term/90) legislators supported by AIUDF members. A section of the members from the treasury bench tried to counter the opposition members with utter noise. Amid a deafening din, governor Purohit concluded his 77 page speech halfway.

Finance minister Himanta Biswa Sarma will table the annual finance budget on February (/taxonomy/term/1898) 7 (/taxonomy/term/1898).

As (/taxonomy/term/2291) the House assembled in the morning Jorhat MLA Hiten Goswami filed nomination papers for the post of Speaker and was elected unanimously. Chief minister Sonowal, opposition leader (/taxonomy/term/1820) Debobrata Saikia welcomed Goswami who hoped cooperation from all sides.
