V Shanmuganathan resigns

Now its official. V Shanmuganathan has pulled out of the Meghalaya (/taxonomy/term/2343) Raj Bhawan after he was allegedly turned the top office into a young ladies' club.

Shanmugnathan who also holds the charge in Arunachal (/taxonomy/term/2194) Pradesh sent his letter to the President (/taxonomy/term/2432) after he unfurled the tricolour in Itanagar (/taxonomy/term/2394) on Thursday afternoon.

The Rashtrapati Bhawan is learnt to have received the letter to be accepted with the suggestion from the home ministry (/taxonomy/term/1724).

He struck no less controversy (/taxonomy/term/1752) after dozens of the Meghalaya (/taxonomy/term/2343) Raj Bhawan employees sent a letter to prime minister Narendra Modi (/taxonomy/term/2361) alleging sexual misconduct and torture giving much ammunition for Congress (/taxonomy/term/90) chief (/taxonomy/term/2020) minister Mukul Sangma to allege that the Raj Bhawan has turned into a young ladies club.

Sources told Assam Times in Delhi that he was shown the door from the Centre after the prime minister received the stunning allegations against (/taxonomy/term/1929) him.

Shanmugnathan was intially posted in Meghalaya (/taxonomy/term/2343) and he was given the additional charge of Arunachal (/taxonomy/term/2194) Pradesh following the exit of JP Rajkhowa (/taxonomy/term/2396) a couple of months back.
