War memories in NE literary works

War memories have given the north east literary works a fresh lease of life. Prolific authors and journalists said at a panel discussion on the last days of Guwahati Lit (/taxonomy/term/2021) Fest on Monday that their literary works have revived the memories of the World War I and II.

Nagaland (/taxonomy/term/1597) writer Easterine Kire, who authored two books said that her book has tried to revive the memories of every notable incidents related to war (/taxonomy/term/2006) in Nagaland (/taxonomy/term/1597). She said her books have captured the entire picture of Nagaland (/taxonomy/term/1597) during the war (/taxonomy/term/2006).

A few Naga remote villages are also shining in her books because of its memorable moments during the wars (/taxonomy/term/2052).

Manipur (/taxonomy/term/64) journalist Pradip Phanjoubam, who was one of the panelists said that his books have tried to deal (/taxonomy/term/1922) with the situation in Manipur (/taxonomy/term/64) during the war (/taxonomy/term/2006).

The role of the Assam Rifles (/taxonomy/term/77) in the second world war (/taxonomy/term/2006) finds a prominent place in his works, said the writer. He maintained the wars (/taxonomy/term/2052) have left an indelible page in the literary works of the north eastern region.
