

Will BJP-BPF honeymoon end?

An escalating [war](#) of words between BJP and BPF [leaders](#) starts posing a serious threat to the one year old Sarbanabda Sonowal government. Both the parties have no dearth of issues to take on each other which is bound to embitter the alliance they struck last year.

BPF president [Hagrama Mohilary](#) has accused the BJP [leaders](#) of threatening him and his party of an impending defeat if BJP is not allowed to take a deep grip in BTAD areas.
