Will Manipur see light of development

Amid a paralyzing shit down call by the rebel outfits Prime minister Narendra Modi (/taxonomy/term/2361) on Saturday addressed a poll rally in Manipur (/taxonomy/term/64) promising to put the north eastern state (/taxonomy/term/2332) back on the wheel.

In his address at the rally in West Imphal (/taxonomy/term/72), Modi said that if BJP is voted to power the state (/taxonomy/term/2332) would see the light of development within a period of 15 months.

Taking a dig at Congress (/taxonomy/term/90), Modi blamed the ruling party for the present state (/taxonomy/term/2332) of affairs and charged the party with ruining the state (/taxonomy/term/2332).

He said, "After coming to power in 2014, we came out with 'Act (/taxonomy/term/1974) East (/taxonomy/term/2485) Policy. Since the last 40 years no PM has come to north-east (/taxonomy/term/2485) for NEC meeting. After Morarji Desai I am the only one who visited."

Normal life came to a grinding halt on Saturday following the 12 hour statewide bandh (/taxonomy/term/100) call opposing Modi's visit to the state (/taxonomy/term/2332). This has forced the authority to ensure tight security in the restive state (/taxonomy/term/2332).

Initially, the rally was organized at the Kangla Fort which was later shifted to Langjing Achouba when People Resurgence and Justice Alliance (PRJA) led by Irom Sharmila opposed.
