

Woman dies of tea poisoning



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A woman died after she consumed a cup of tea brewing trouble for a tea company.

The incident took place at Aathkhelia area in the district where identified as Pramolota Saikia, fell sick along with her husband and son after sipping tea in the morning.

According to information, the trio complained of uneasiness and vomiting half an hour after consuming tea of Golden Eagle brand of Binani Group.

Premolota died in the morning while husband and son are undergoing treatment in Golaghat Civil Hospital.
