### World Health Day observed at press club

The city [\(/taxonomy/term/1957\)](#) based Dispur Hospitals today organized a free diabetes screening and a Hepatitis-B vaccination camp to observe the World Health [\(/taxonomy/term/51\)](#) Day at Guwahati Press Club. Nearly hundred media persons participated in the program where over [\(/taxonomy/term/2166\)](#) 50 scribes took the first dose of Hepatitis-B vaccine (in addition to 15 second dose recipients).
