

## Zeliang visits Burma Camp Market



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KOHIMA: [Nagaland](#) chief minister TR Zeliang on Saturday visited the Burma Camp [Market](#) a day after a huge [inferno](#) razed down a cluster of thatch houses.

Expressing his sadness [over](#) the unfortunate incident, the Chief Minister assured the affected families and Elders of the area present at the spot that all possible measures would be taken up.

While donating Rs. 10,20,000 as immediate relief for the affected families which was handed [over](#) to the District Administration, he termed the incident as 'very unfortunate'.

A total of 102 families who lost their homes to the ravishing fire would get Rs. 10,000 each from the amount even as [Nagaland](#) State Disaster Management Agency (NSDMA) and the District Administration have been directed to immediately [start](#) assessing the ground realities for further necessary action.

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
